THE 1991 GREY CUP LEGACY FUND was established by the Grey Cup Festival Committee, with the surplus funds arising from the holding of the 1991 Grey Cup Game in Winnipeg, to promote excellence in football and other sports in Manitoba through the development of coaching expertise.

The FUND is held in trust and administered by the University of Manitoba in consultation with an Awards Committee consisting of representatives from the Government of Manitoba, the City of Winnipeg, the universities of Brandon, Winnipeg and Manitoba, the Blue Bombers Football Club and Coaching Manitoba.

The program of activities to be supported by the FUND in this sixteenth year of operation (2009-2010) includes:

1. Coaching Scholarships tenable in Manitoba universities
2. Support for Coaching Seminars
3. Support for "Coach-in-Residence" Programs
4. Support for Sport Management Internships
5. Awarding of a prize for the "High School Coach of the Year"

Award Name: COACHING SEMINARS AWARDS PROGRAM

Award Criteria: Grants in support of coaching seminars may be made to host organization (university or provincial/regional sport association). Seminars must occur between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010. The Coaching Seminars Program is targeted at the development of coaches within a sport, or a number of sports, at the grassroots, developmental or high performance levels. Coaches need to be provided the opportunity to share and expand their knowledge, improve their skills and participate in coaching development seminars to supplement the information and techniques they have developed through the National Coaching Certification Program and their own experiences. Preference will be given to those organizations who offer innovative seminars not previously funded by the Fund.

Award Value: Two grants of up to \$4,000.
